

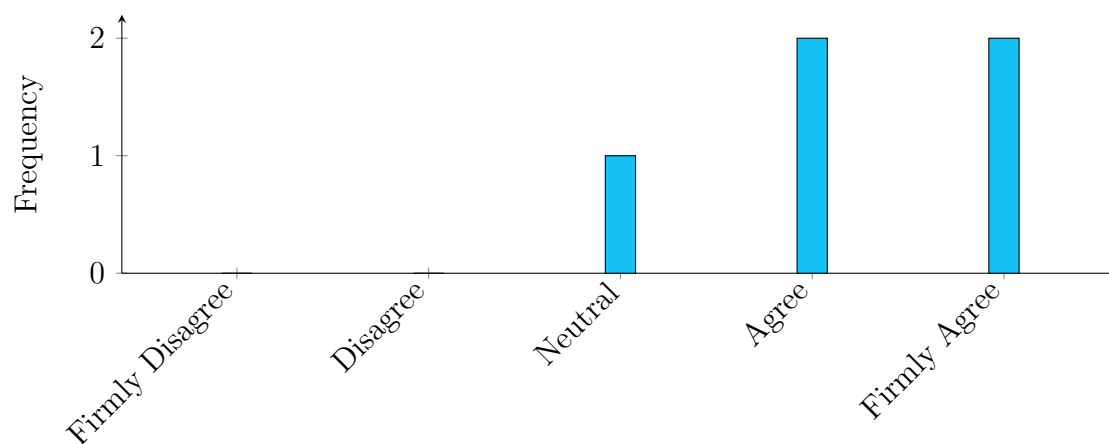

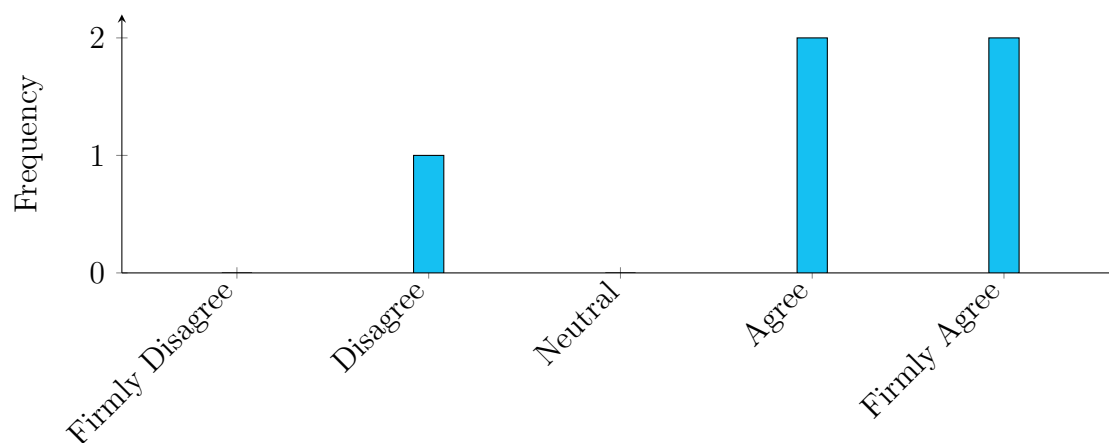

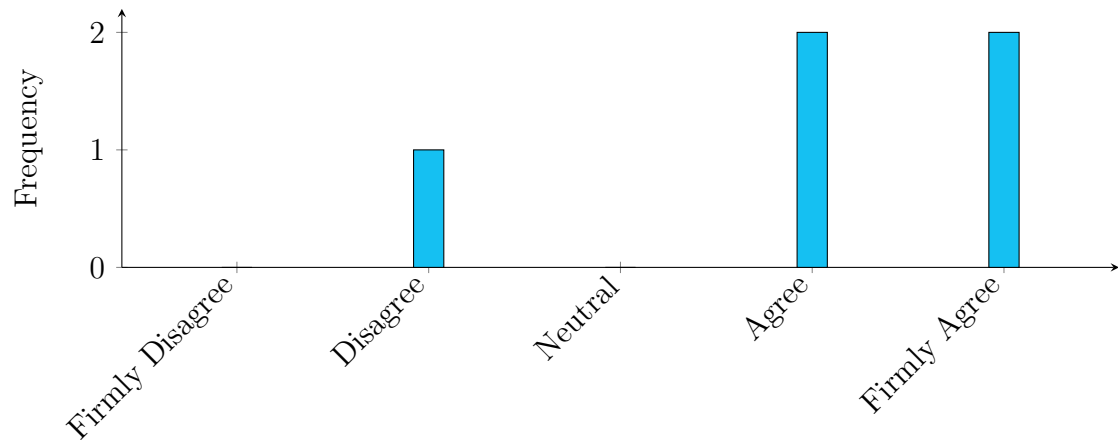
The supervision during the sessions was good.
