

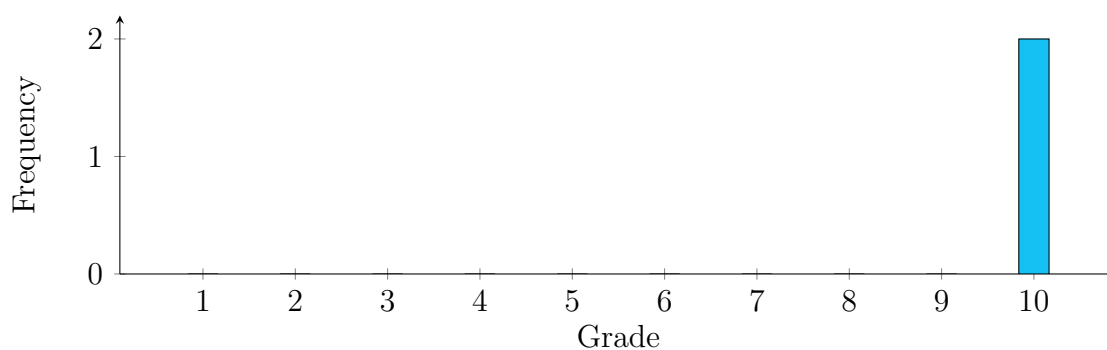

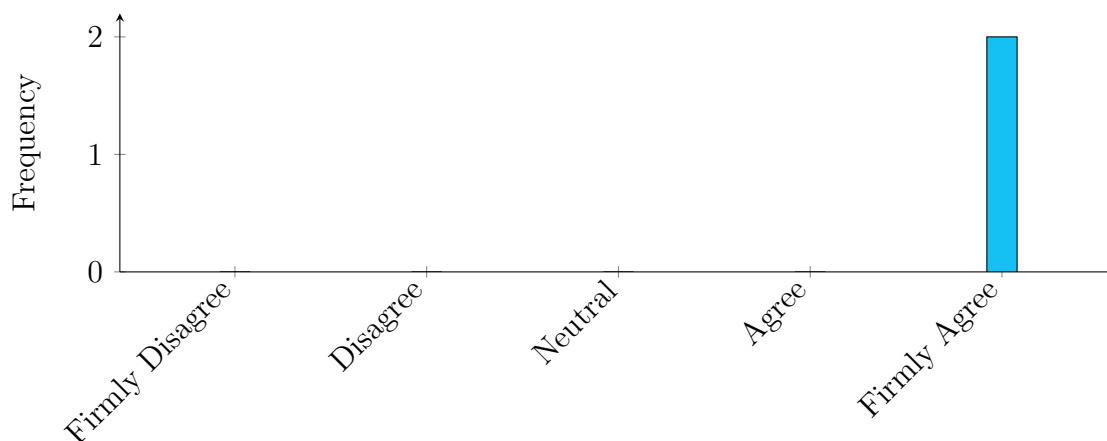

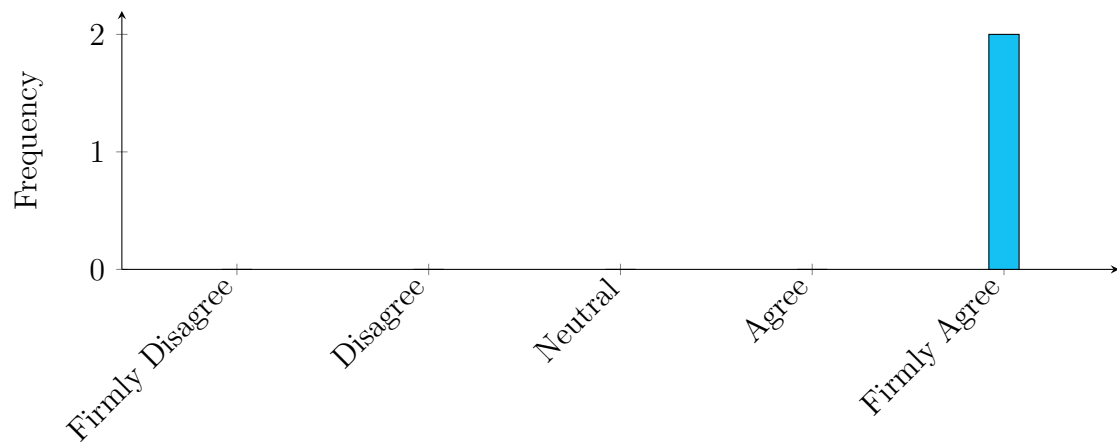
Assessment of the supervisor (Dutch grading scale).



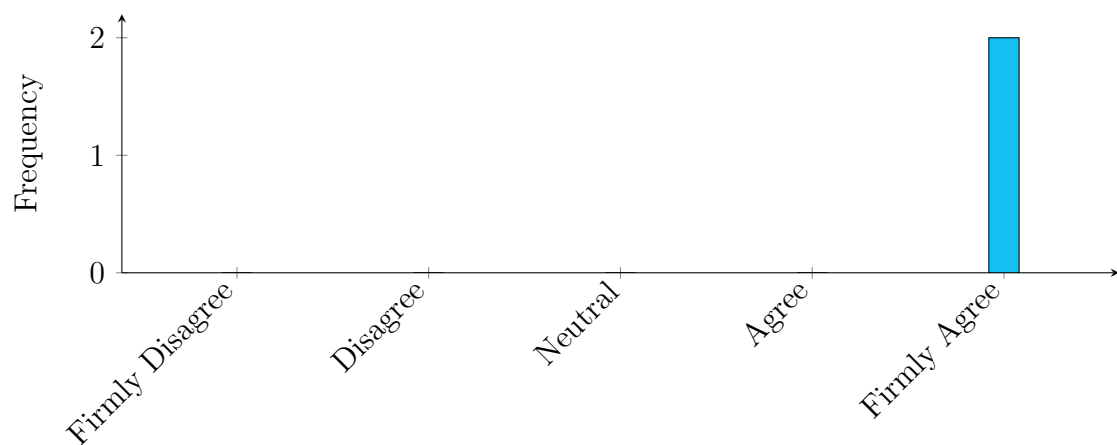
I was well aware of the expectations and requirements of my supervisor.
